Breed:	Red Boer Goat (Stud and Commercial both acceptable)
Sex:	Male and Female

Customer Specification / Selection Criteria:

- AUSTREX will apply pre-numbered export VisTags in each ear to all animals selected.
- Commercial and Stud animals accepted
- Stud animals presented with certificate will be paid a premium price

Selection Process

- Payment terms are 14 days from delivery. *Payment to Vendors are subject to receipt of the following completed and signed documentation:*
 - Protocol Vendor Declaration – completed. Copy left on farm for signing day animals leave the property. Must accompany truck to Quarantine.
 - Any applicable breed certificates



- Agent Sales Agreement to be signed at time of purchase specifying
 - Price
 - Specifications
 - Contracted Numbers
 - Delivery details
 - AUSTREX visual tag numbers
 - Other Selection requirements/conditions
 - Animals subject to POO Clearance and any on-farm protocol requirements

- Special Conditions
 - Subject to receiving of Chinese Import Permit
 - Subject to AUSTREX Buyer inspection
 - Subject to Chinese selectors final selection on-farm
 - A Land Transport Declaration must be completed when goats are delivered to quarantine
 - If land transport journeys are greater than 8 hours or more than 2 hours interstate, then a Travel Plan for Journeys Greater Than 8 Hours is to be completed.

Documents to collect from Vendors once Heifers are tagged by AUSTREX at end of selection on each farm:

1. RFID scan of animals tagged for export
2. Completed Chinese Protocol Vendor Declaration;
3. Contract signed with farmers;

Import Country Requirements – all cattle sourced for export must comply with the importing country protocol requirements:

- Property of Origin Clearances
- On Farm Tests – On Farm Blood tests are required and will be carried out by AAV
- Health Protocol Vendor Declaration is to be completed in FULL and signed by the vendor/owner of the cattle at the time of selection
- JD Documentation
