

## Attention goat meat producers

Meat and Livestock Australia (MLA), in conjunction with the Goat Industry Council of Australia (GICA), have commissioned a project to identify and promote ways of improving the reproductive performance of meat goat herds in Australia. Forest Hill Consulting is conducting the project on behalf of MLA and GICA.

**As a goat meat producer there are two ways that you can contribute to improving your industry through this project.**

1. Go to the '[Dough from Doe\\$](#)' website and register your contact details to be part of the project database. The database will be maintained by MLA and GICA and allow for improved communication and extension within the industry. You can choose to make yourself available to be contacted by the consultants to provide some brief information about your production system (via a 15-20 minute telephone conversation). The information you provide will be presented anonymously as collated data within the final report. Approximately 50 growers from various geographical areas will be engaged for this stage of the project.
2. Identify yourself, if you have an advanced breeding goat meat enterprise and are prepared to share the details of this production system for the purposes of this project and report. This information would be presented as a case study. We are looking for approximately six case studies.

Please register for the database, and/or nominate your advanced breeding program, no later than **Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> February 2019**.
